I also need to find the moonlight.




The moonlight will be my guide. But which one is the moonlight? There are so many lights here.

Let's Learn About: Fireflies and Termites

Have you heard of an insect called a termite? It's a small creature that lives in groups (colonies). They like to eat wood, including the wood in your house. Fireflies are a type of termite.

They're the only type that have wings. The other two types of termites are worker termites and soldier termites. Worker termites are responsible for preparing the nest, finding food, and serving the other termites. Soldier termites are responsible for guarding the nest from other animals, like ants.



What is the role of a firefly? Fireflies have a different and very important role! Fireflies are responsible for finding mates to build nests, reproduce, and form new colonies.

When they start their mission, fireflies look for moonlight. Fireflies need the moonlight as a guide to fly long distances. However, in places with lots of light, fireflies get confused. They find it hard to distinguish the light. That's why we often see fireflies swarming around lights.

If fireflies don't find a mate, they can only survive for one night. If they succeed in finding a mate, they will form a new colony or group. Female fireflies can lay thirty thousand eggs in one day.
