



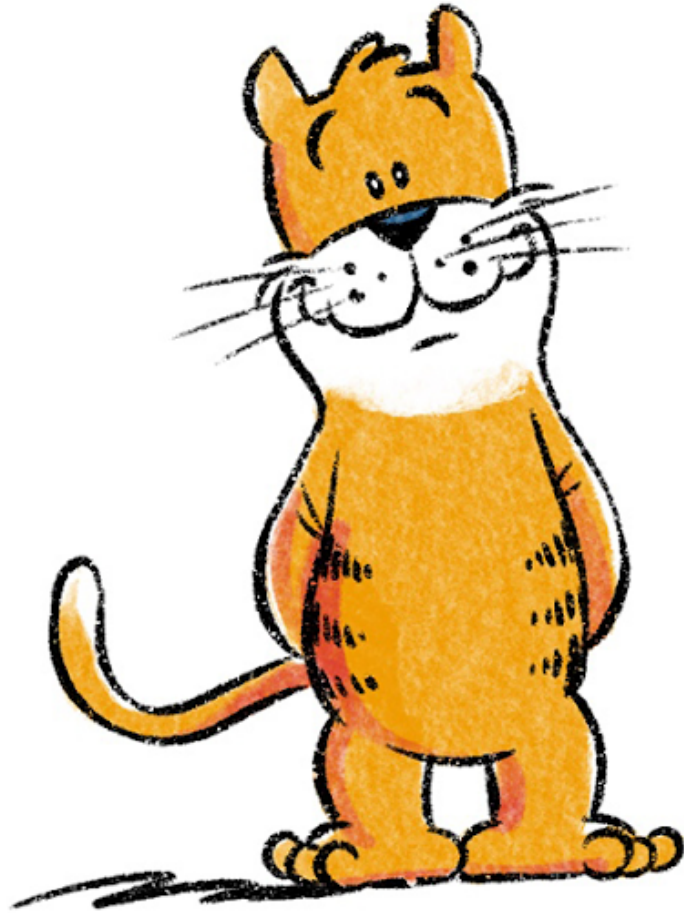

Cat says, "I am painting a sky full of clouds and rain.

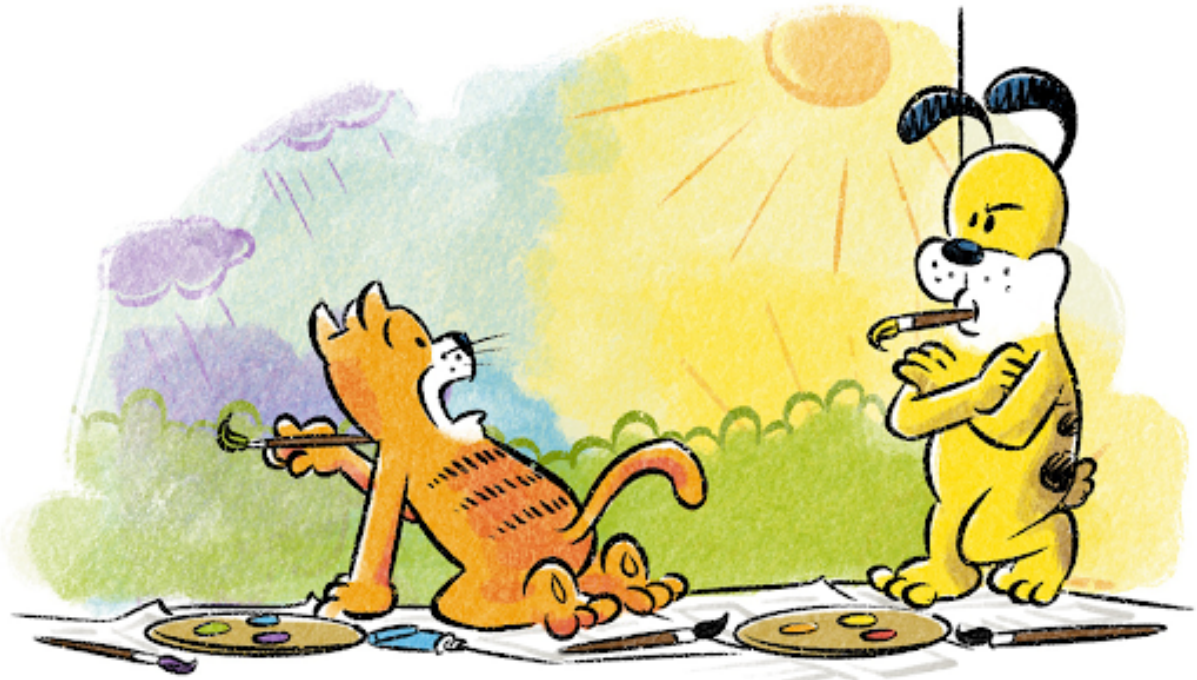
Because I like the rain."

He starts with yellow and orange.



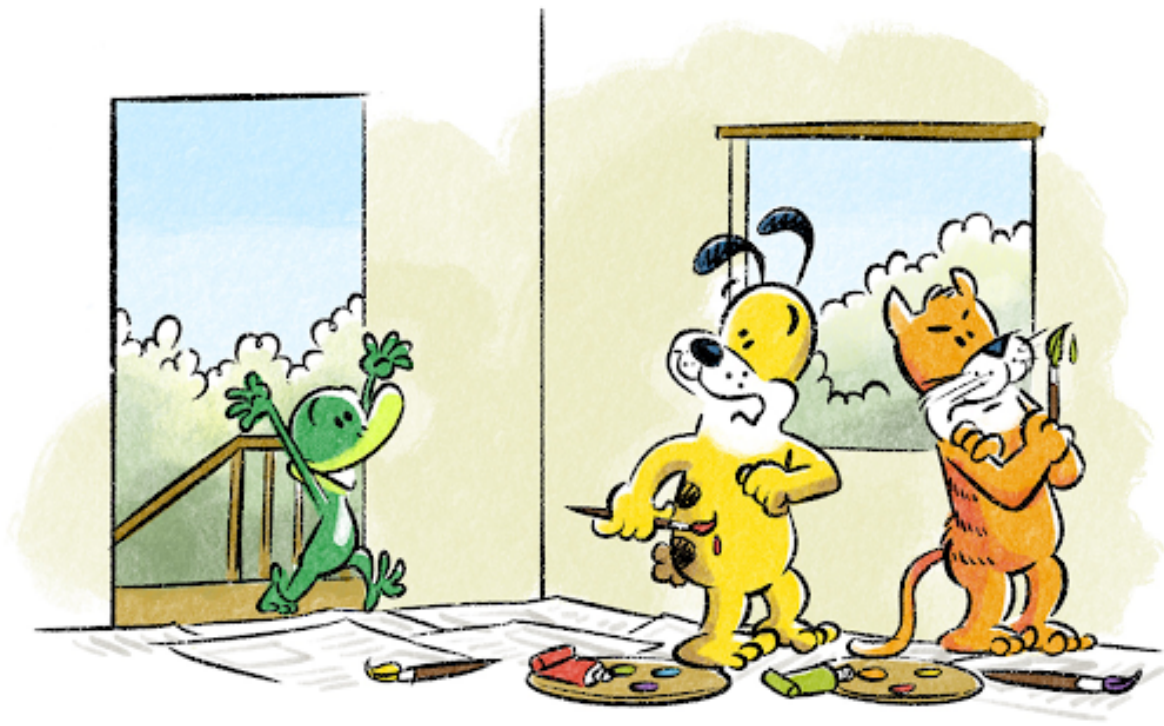
Cat says, "I like the rain, because plants need rain to grow."

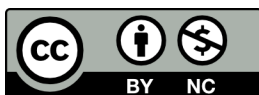
